

# THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHATSWORTH

## BY-LAW NUMBER 2017- 29

Being a by-law to provide for alternate voting methods for the 2018 municipal and school board election

**WHEREAS** Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 as amended provides that a municipal council may pass by-laws authorizing electors to use an alternative voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote; and


**WHEREAS** Council wishes to employ vote by mail for the 2018 school board and municipal election;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Township of Chatsworth hereby enacts as follows:


1. That the use of vote by mail as an alternative voting method is hereby authorized in respect of the municipal and school board election to be held in 2018.
2. That the Clerk/Returning Officer is authorized to determine the length of the voting period, including advanced voting.
3. The Clerk/Returning Officer is authorized to enter into agreements with selected vendors necessary for the election.
4. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon its passing.

Read a first and second time this 19<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2017.

Read a third time and finally passed this 19<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2017.
