Flooding Update – April 9th, 2016

- The Sullivan Landfill Site will be open for residents affected by flooding to take debris from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Friday April 8, 2016 through to Friday April 15, 2016 excluding Sunday April 10. On Saturday April 9 and Monday April 11, the landfill will be open the normal hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- The Markdale Landfill site will continue to have landfill fees; however residents affected by flooding can bring their receipts to the Township of Chatsworth Municipal Office for reimbursement. There are no extended hours at the Markdale Landfill site.
- Waste Bins are available to residents affected by flooding at the end of Orr Street and one for McCullough Lake residents at East Park Road.
- Bottled water is available at the Township of Chatsworth Municipal Office and the Chatsworth Fire Hall at any time for residents affected by flooding. It is also available at the Williamsford Community Centre after 2 p.m. on Sunday April 10.
- Township is allowing residents and cottage owners that reside on the closed roads on McCullough Lake to be able to access their properties via a "CLOSED ROAD".
- For those unable to take their water sample to the Grey Bruce Public Health Unit, please drop it off at the Township of Chatsworth Municipal Office prior to 10:00 a.m. Monday through Friday.
